

Waterfowl Observation Area



Treadwell Bay is an excellent waterfowl observation area. Several species such as Mallard, American Black Duck, Bufflehead, Common Goldeneye, Common Merganser, Red-breasted Merganser, Canada Goose, Brant and Snow Goose, among others, can be observed at various times throughout the year. Many species of shorebirds can also be seen during the warmer months along the lakeshore. Several thousand Snow Geese rafting up in the bay are a very common sight during their Fall migration.
